

## Did Social Security overpay you between March 1, 2020 and September 30, 2020? Did Social Security find this overpayment?

If you answered yes to both questions, then you might qualify for a special waiver from Social Security. Here is what you should do:

- 1. File a Request for Waiver Overpayment Recovery (Form SSA-632BK). You can find the form online at <a href="https://www.ssa.gov/forms/ssa-632.html">https://www.ssa.gov/forms/ssa-632.html</a>. Or you can call your local office to ask for the form.
- 2. Send the completed form to Social Security. Keep a copy for yourself. Keep proof of how you sent it. For example, the fax cover page or a certified mail receipt.

If you have questions about how to fill out the form, do not get a decision from Social Security, or Social Security denies your request, then you can call (513) 241-9400 to ask Legal Aid for help.
