

Coronavirus Relief Funds for Housing & Utility Assistance

Ohioans who are behind on the rent, mortgage, water and/or sewer payments may be eligible for assistance through the Coronavirus Relief Funds. Here is how and where to apply in our Southwest Ohio Counties:

Adams Brown Community Action Partnership

How to apply: Call (937) 378-6041, extension 254

Agency hours: Monday – Friday, 8am - 4:30pm
Relief funds can be used for assistance with utility bills in Brown County.

For rent or mortgage assistance, individuals need to apply through Brown County Job and Family Services.

Brown County Job & Family Services

How to apply: Clients must go into JFS's office at:

Individuals must complete a PRC application, and must link their situation to the fact that they've been affected by COVID. A statement from the landlord regarding how much back rent they owe is also required.

Agency hours: Monday – Friday, 8am - 5:00pm
Relief funds can be used for housing assistance.

Relief funds can be used for rent or mortgage assistance for the specific period of April 1, 2020-December 30, 2020. Mortgage assistance can include taxes and insurance if escrowed. Individuals can also obtain assistance for sewer and water utilities.
