

# Summer Crisis Program & E-HEAP

Have your utilities been disconnected? Or have you been threatened with disconnection? If so, you may be eligible for the **Summer Crisis Program**, an emergency component of the **Home Energy Assistance Program (E-HEAP)**.



## Summer Crisis Program

The Summer Crisis Program is a one-time benefit that is available from **July 1st through September 30th, 2020**. If you are eligible, you can receive assistance toward your utility bill or central air conditioning repairs, or you may receive an air conditioning unit or fan.

- Customers with regulated utility service may receive a maximum benefit of \$500.
- Customers with unregulated utility service may receive a maximum benefit of \$800.

**To be eligible for assistance**, your household income must be at or below 175% of the [Federal Poverty Guidelines](#), and:

- Your utility service has been disconnected or is in threat of immediate disconnection;
- You are attempting to establish new utility service;
- You have a household member who is age 60 or older, or;
- You have a household member with a documented medical condition.
